The crucifixion means that ‘God, in the person of his Son, put himself voluntarily and deliberately into the place of greatest accursedness and Godlessness—for us’ (p. 104). The ‘sentence of accursedness has fallen upon Jesus on our behalf [as representative] and in our place [as substitute], by his own decree as the second person’ of the Trinity (p. 100).

The rectifying death of the Son was an act of God; not humanity, and not Jesus as a man separated from the divine nature. Throughout *The Crucifixion*, there are some major themes that are often repeated, two of which (at least) are absolutely central to the entire volume. First, this is a deeply apocalyptic treatment of the crucifixion. Apocalyptic theology (one of the best known proponents of which, J. Louis Martyn, is a major influence on Rutledge's thought) stresses the two-age schema—the old age of sin and death and the new age inaugurated by the coming & atoning work of the Messiah.
